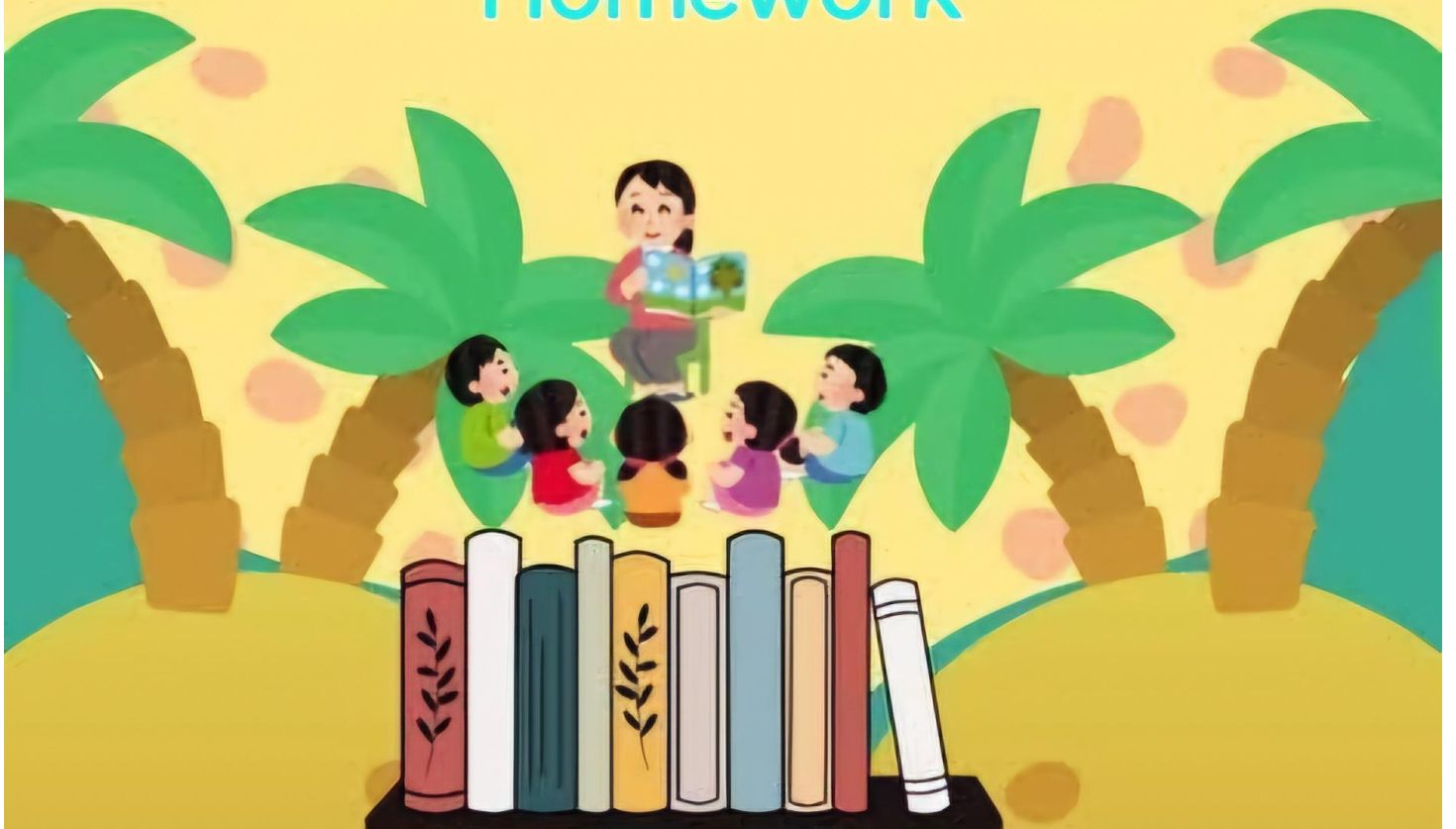

- ❖ **Holiday Homework Submission date is 08/07/2025.**

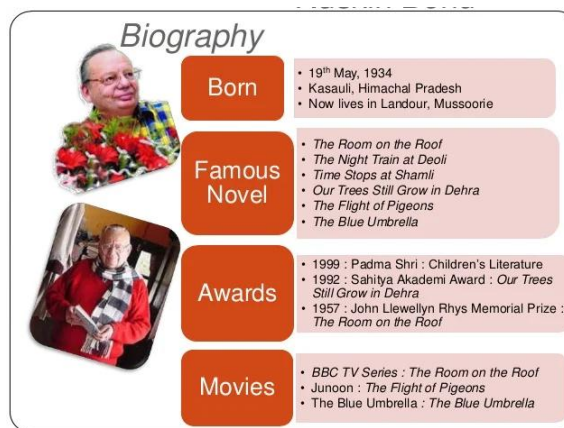
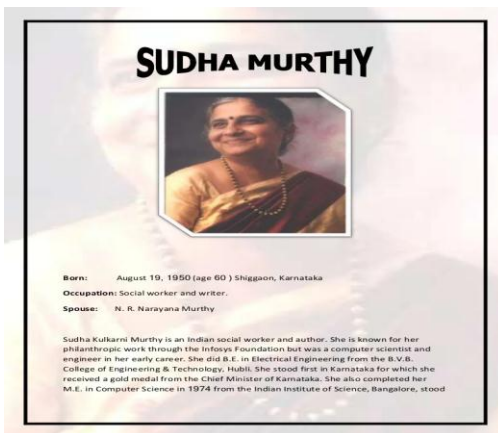

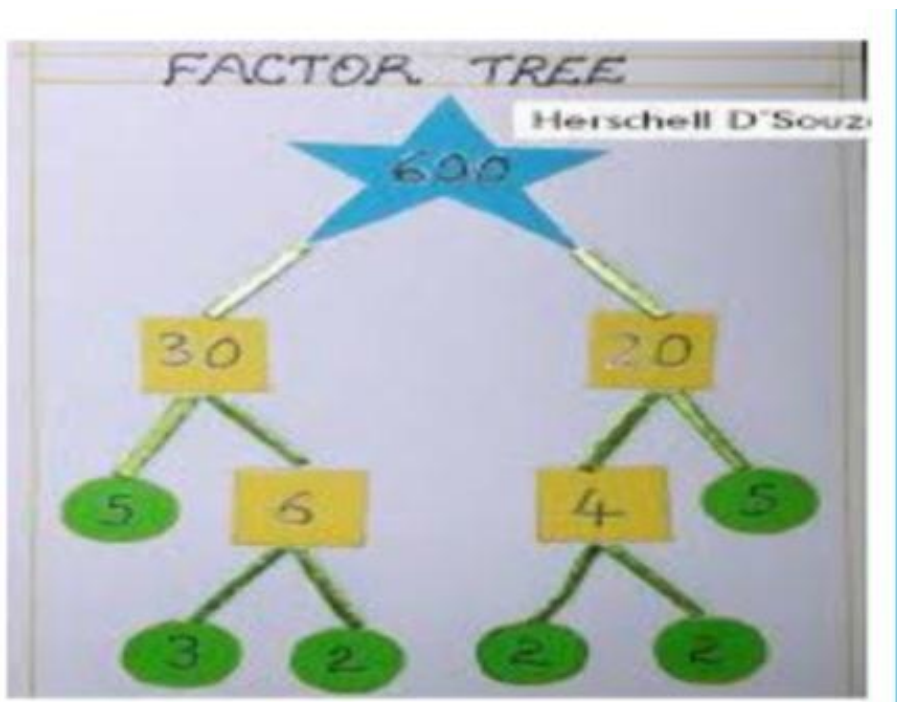

Q2. Poster making on “Reduce, Reuse and Recycle”. Use cardboard, watercolours, glue, cotton, chart paper, etc.



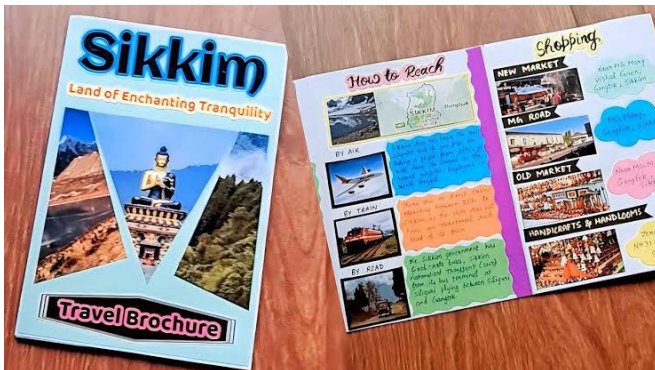
